

International Corporate Leadership Programme

The **International Corporate Leadership Programme (ICLP)** provides companies with top quality engineering students to work with them for up to two years, with a full package of support from the University of Leeds.

ICLP - 'Graduates ready for business'

In 1999, the Keyworth Institute launched a programme to meet a need identified by numerous leading industrial companies for high quality engineering graduates who possess a 'wider skill base', including international, business and leadership awareness. Since that time we have continued to develop ICLP in close consultation with our industrial partners. The full programme consists of two summer work placements (at the end of the second and third years of the four year MEng degree), an individual project in the third year and a team project in the fourth year. The content of the placements and projects are defined by the company. Throughout their work the students are supported by industrial and academic mentors provided by the University and are also required to take specially designed academic modules in management and personal development skills.



A uniquely integrated approach

- The summer work placements, company-based individual and team projects and specially designed academic modules are **integrated** to provide real benefits for the company and a powerful learning experience for the student
- Each student is **mentored** by an academic mentor and a consultant senior industrialist, to ensure a focus on delivery. A company mentor will also be involved
- Each student is **sponsored** by the company (£1,000 per year) and receives a salary for the period of their work placement
- The programme is **managed** throughout by the Keyworth Institute, we provide all of the marketing and administration to support the programme

Maintaining the highest standard in relevant disciplines

The Keyworth Institute acts a 'one-stop shop' for you to access students studying in the following subject areas, all of which were rated at the top scoring 5/5* level in the Government's most recent Research Assessment Exercise:

- Chemical Engineering • Materials Engineering • Civil Engineering
- Mechanical Engineering • Electronic and Electrical Engineering
- Mining and Minerals Engineering • Fuel and Energy • Product Design

To be eligible to apply for the ICLP, students must score an average 60% or more in their second undergraduate year and be on target for a 2:1 or higher Master of Engineering degree.

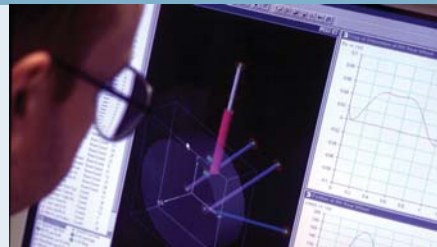
What does it cost?

The cost is a competitive £2,600, plus VAT, per student per year (a contribution of £1,600 to the ICLP overheads plus financial sponsorship of £1,000 per student) plus the student's salary (£200-£250 per week, when they are working at your company).

For Yorkshire & Humber manufacturing companies we can reduce the cost by providing access to grant funding of approximately £2,000 per student per year.
